HARTGE YACHT YARD RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING IN PREPARATION FOR STORAGE OF YOUR BOAT.

- NO alcohol, kerosene, charcoal, LPG, CNG cylinders, or gasoline in portable fuel tanks⁽¹⁾.
 - Vessels in dry storage are not to be plugged into shore power unless you are in attendance⁽¹⁾.
 - Bilge must be clean and free of oil, antifreeze, and other pollutants⁽¹⁾.
 - All furling headsails must be removed.
 - Fuel tanks should be 90% FULL and Holding Tanks EMPTY.
 - Batteries should be charged monthly. Batteries lose about 10% of their charge a month, even with no draw.
- Fill fuel tanks Pump out holding tank(s) Store CNG/LPG tank Add fuel treatment
 Clean bilge Store outboard Winterize & store outboard Winterize outboard fuel tank & fuel line
 Charge batteries onboard monthly⁽²⁾ - OR - Remove /store/charge batteries - OR - Owner will take care of batteries

RIGGING:

HULLSIDES: -- CHOOSE ONE --

BOAT COVERS: -- CHOOSE ONE -- *Boats should be clean before covering. Power boats w/high superstructure are more expensive.*
 Shrink wrap to waterline - DRY STORED SAIL BOATS - \$24/ft
 Shrink wrap to cover whole deck not hullsides (*It is better not to cover painted hullsides*) - DRY STORED BOATS - \$22/ft
 Shrink wrap to cover whole deck- WET STORED SAIL BOATS - \$26/ft
 Install owner's winter cover (*location of cover*) _____
