B) Unless instructed otherwise over the winter we will: 1) Paint underwater hardware with Petit Barnacle Barrier and 2) Install new zincs.

- Owner would like to have HYY deliver boat for storage.       Owner will deliver boat to Hartge Yacht Yard.
- Remove lines from slip (at no charge).

**HARTGE YACHT YARD RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING IN PREPARATION FOR STORAGE OF YOUR BOAT.**

- NO alcohol, kerosene, charcoal, LPG, CNG cylinders, or gasoline in portable fuel tanks <sup>(1)</sup>.
- Vessels in dry storage are not to be plugged into shore power unless you are in attendance <sup>(1)</sup>.
- Bilge must be clean and free of oil, antifreeze, and other pollutants <sup>(1)</sup>.
- All furling headsails must be removed.
- Fuel tanks should be 90% FULL and Holding Tanks EMPTY.
- Batteries should be charged monthly. Batteries lose about 10% of their charge a month, even with no draw.

- Fill fuel tanks     Pump out holding tank(s)     Store CNG/LPG tank     Add fuel treatment
- Clean bilge     Store outboard     Winterize & store outboard     Winterize outboard fuel tank & fuel line
- Charge batteries onboard monthly <sup>(2)</sup> - OR -  Remove/store/charge batteries - OR -  Owner will take care of batteries

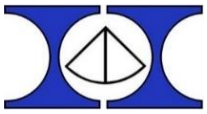

**MECHANICAL WINTERIZING: Winterize my boat after \_\_\_\_\_ date.**

Typically, we winterize our customers boats including all of the items listed in this section. At spring commissioning, we do engine zincs, raw water impellers, fuel filters, and stuffing box checks. It helps us if you mark the boxes for all equipment you want us to winterize. Some equipment can be hidden and overlooked. # HARTGE YACHT YARD – WINTER STORAGE & WORK ORDER 2018/2019

## WINTERIZING THE HULL / HARDWARE / RIGGING.

### RIGGING:

- HYY to remove sails and store below (*removal of roller furled jibs required for dry stored boats*).
- Location of sail bags \_\_\_\_\_
- Send sails for repair/wash/and storage to \_\_\_\_\_ Sailmaker.
- Location of sails and sail bags.
- Un-step and store mast.
- Remove and store radio, electronics and masthead wind indicator.
- Check, clean and lube thru hull valves (only if boat is hauled).
- Sand and varnish spars.
- Check, clean and lube furling system.

### HULLSIDES:

-- CHOOSE ONE --

- Clean & wax gelcoat hullside
- Compound & wax gelcoat hullsides
- Clean & seal Awlgrip hullsides

### DECKS, CABINTOP & COCKPIT:

-- CHOOSE ONE --

- Clean and wax gelcoat decks
- Compound and wax gelcoat decks
- Clean & seal Awlgrip decks
- Sand and varnish exterior brightwork. (*Weather permitting! Order must be received ASAP.*)

### BOAT COVERS:

-- CHOOSE ONE -- *Boats should be clean before covering. Power boats w/high superstructure are more expensive.*

- Shrink wrap to waterline – DRY STORED SAILBOATS - \$24/ft.
- Shrink wrap to cover whole deck not hullside (*It is better not to cover painted hullsides*) – DRY STORED BOATS - \$22/ft.
- Shrink wrap to cover whole deck – WET STORED SAIL BOATS \$26/ft.
- Install owner's winter cover (*location of cover*) \_\_\_\_\_

### INSPECTIONS:

- Deck Inspection (\$4/ft. LOA)
- Mechanical Inspection (\$100/hr. 1-3 hrs.)
- Corrosion Inspection (\$100/hr. 1-3 hrs.)
- Rigging Inspection (*as time permits*) (\$2/ft. x length of mast)
